## **STOKESLEY SHOW SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19<sup>th</sup> 2026**

Thank you for kindly taking a trade stand in the 167<sup>th</sup> year of Stokesley Show. The terms and conditions of booking your trade stand are as stated below. To keep us correct could you kindly make sure a copy of your Public Liability Insurance for the show is available on request on Show day and kindly forward a copy of the same to us by the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2026.

1. Invoices for the deposit and balance will follow, from our accounts department. Your pitch is not confirmed until the deposit and balances invoices are settled in full.
2. If you wish to purchase extra advance tickets for yourselves, these are available at a cost of £14.00 incl vat each.
3. Because of the risks involved to the public and others by Trade-stands and the provision of services at the show, all exhibitors and those who provide services are required to have Public Liability insurance in the total sum of not less than £5,000,000 and to indemnify Stokesley Agricultural Society, against all claims of whatever nature by members of the public, or others, relating to the trade exhibitors and those who provide services. The trade exhibitors and those who provide services are required to produce written evidence of such insurance arrangements on demand and in any event the details on the booking form/remittance advice.
4. The society cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to property. Steps are taken to provide security patrols in the week leading up to the show, but exhibitors should make their own security arrangements, if required. Under Health & Safety rules, all exhibitors must prepare and have available for inspection on the day of the show, their own Risk Assessment for the event.
5. There shall be no sub-letting of stand space or collections on behalf of charities (specified charity stands are exempt from this) without written permission of the Chairman of Council.
6. No games of chance, mock auctions or collecting buckets allowed. Unless standing as an invited charity or with authorisation from the show Secretary.
7. All exhibitors, entering the show-ground, must have wrist band attached. If extras are needed please order when booking. All trade stand vehicles must display relevant car park pass. Failure to comply will result in refused entry to the showground.
8. Please remember that your allocated space must include caravan drawbars, marquee ropes and other materials.
9. Fire extinguishers are compulsory for all Trade-stands and each stand must provide their own extinguishers.
10. Generators must be silenced and cause no pollution (noise, fumes, obstruction etc) to other traders or members of the public.



11. The site allocated will be available five days before the show and should be completed by the eve of the show or at the latest by 8:00 am on show day – no vehicle movement will be permitted on show day after 8.00am due to public access. All exhibits and equipment must be cleared not later than seven days after the date of the show and stallholders are responsible for clearing away their own rubbish.
12. If you are wishing to sell alcohol, you will need to apply for a temporary event notice (TENS). You must also inform ourselves before any application is made for the sale of alcohol. We require to see a copy of the successful application before show date, this must also be available on show day and comply with the necessary regulations.
13. The use of glass drinking vessels is strictly prohibited across the site for open sales or hospitality.
14. No Steward, Official or fellow Exhibitor should be subject to violent, threatening, or abusive behaviour, either before, during or after the Show. Those deemed to contradict this rule will be refused entry, or asked to leave the show-ground and will forfeit their entry fees.
15. Stokesley Agricultural Society provides complimentary wireless internet access across the Showground for the benefit of Tradestands and Catering concessions. This service is offered free of charge and is intended solely to support essential business functions, such as processing transactions. While every reasonable effort will be made to maintain reliable internet connectivity during the event, users should be aware that wireless services are subject to external factors that may affect performance.
16. Should you need to cancel your Tradestand prior to the event, the Society reserves the right to re-let the cancelled space. The following refunds will be applicable;
  - Up to and including 30<sup>th</sup> June – full refund of monies paid
  - Up to and including 20<sup>th</sup> August – 50% of monies paid
  - 21<sup>st</sup> August onwards – No refundTradestand holders are advised to carry their own cancellation insurance.
17. Trade stands can be set up from the Thursday prior to the Show and whilst we do have Security on the show field, all items left are at your own risk. No movement of vehicles after 8.00 am on Show day. All trade stands to be in position by 8.00 am.
18. Attendance at the show and payment of the invoice will be deemed to be full and unequivocal acceptance of the terms and conditions above.

A trophy to be held for one year will be awarded to the Best Trade Stand.
